Planning application for: 2490/2500 Bloor Street West

Site

The sites are located east and west of Old Mill Drive at its junction with Bloor Street West. The sites are currently occupied by an office building and an automobile dealership.

Proposal

This application is for a stepped 16 storey, commercial/residential building at 2490 Bloor Street West, containing 271 condominium apartments and 1,020m² ground floor retail space; and, a stepped 13 storey residential building at 2500 Bloor Street West, containing 217 condominium apartments.

Purpose of the Meeting

The meeting will provide an opportunity for the community to have input on this project, view the plans and ask site and process related questions. It will be followed, on July 8th with an in-depth design review of the site and its context. Some volunteers will be requested, at the meeting, to be involved in that review.
